Support long-term operations & maintenance funding for transit networks across Ontario.

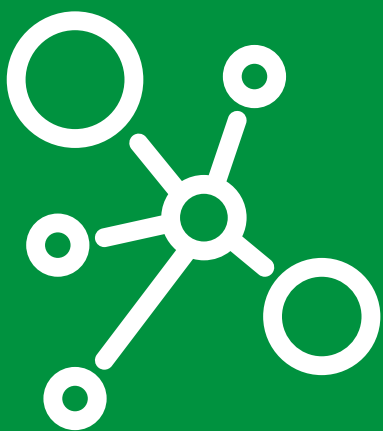
Enhancing the GO Transit Network



Prioritize plans to electrify GO Transit's rail network and have timelines for full implementation.



Accelerate all-day, two-way GO rail service network-wide along with preparations to implement level boarding.



Allocate funds for a new electric train fleet, increase bus frequencies and hire more operators.

Building Homes Near Transit



Upzone lands near transit corridors to address housing needs and for closer connections to the network.



Prioritize affordability and accessibility in developments near Major Transit Station Areas for future residents.



Address community needs by helping to fund additional services and amenities alongside new housing.

Buses and Active Transportation



Enhance last-mile transit solutions and improve bus connections to train schedules.



Support the expansion of intercity bus services, serving new municipalities and locations.



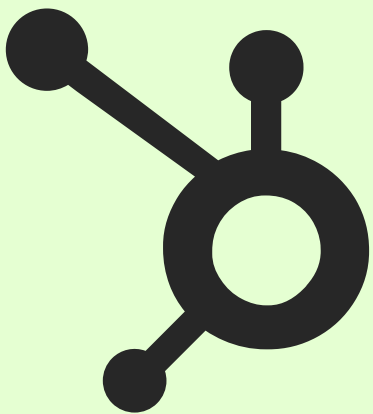
Ensure municipalities have the resources to expand active transportation networks.
